FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Who does Lovell serve?

Lovell has successfully provided over \$280 million of our partners' goods and services to hundreds of federal, state, and local government agencies.

What is an SDVOSB?

A Service-Disabled Veteran-Owned Small Business (SDVOSB) is 51% unconditionally owned and controlled by a service-disabled veteran and must be certified by the Veterans Administration through the VETBIZ process.

What makes Lovell different from other companies?

We are a Federal Set-Aside business with Logistics Officers, Medical Service Corps Officers and War Fighters. We know what our Soldiers, Sailors, Airman, Marines, and Coast Guard need for readiness.

Why Partner with Lovell?

Some reasons include:

- Sole source contracts with no competition, and reduced administrative and contracting time for faster awards due to Federal Set-Aside status
- Stackable and targeted bids are allowed
- Expands your exposure to additional sources of revenue

Are sole-source or set-aside contracts allowed under the SDVOSB program?

Yes. In accordance with 13 C.F.R. 125.19 and 125.20

Can awards be made to SDVOSBs below the simplified acquisition thresholds?

Yes. Contracting officers may set aside requirements at or below the simplified acquisition thresholds for SDVOSBs, using simplified acquisition procedures.

Are joint ventures allowed under the SDVOSB program?

Yes. In accordance with 13 C.F.R. 125.15(b), SDVOSBs may enter into a joint venture agreement with one or more for the purpose of performing an SDVO contract.

May nonmanufacturers submit an offer under the SDVO SBC procurement program?

Yes, in accordance with 13 C.F.R. 125.15(c), an SDVOSB that is a nonmanufacturer may submit an offer on a sole source or set-aside service-disabled veteran-owned.
